Today, Juventas New Music Ensemble announced its new Neighborhood Series, a selection of free concerts around the New England Area. 2023-24 Neighborhood Series performances include September 23 at Parker River National Wildlife Refuge in Newburyport; October 14, and November 18 at First Baptist Church in Medford; and June 23, at Longfellow House–Washington's Headquarters National Historic Site in Cambridge. Additional dates will be announced this winter.

The newly created series broadens Juventas's commitment to making contemporary music accessible to audiences - inside and outside the concert hall. Every concert is available at no cost and is open to the public. The Neighborhood Series joins Juventas's marquee Mainstage offerings in Boston and Cambridge, bringing intimate programs to smaller towns around the Greater Boston Region.

In addition, each program brings our world-class musicians into the community to share music by diverse living composers. 2023-24 Neighborhood Series features music by Quinn Mason, Allison Loggins-Hull, Somei Satoh, Tigran Mansurian, John Patitucci, Michael Donovan, Mary Montgomery Koppel, Emma Wine, Mari Kotskyy, Nyokabi Kariűki, Oliver Caplan, Eric Whitacre, Andrew Porter, and Gina Gillie with more composers to follow.

"For the entire organization's history, we've held free concerts for the community," says Artistic Director Oliver Caplan. "Now we're bringing these offerings under one umbrella and strategically expanding them to make a bigger impact."

Neighborhood Series concerts are free and open to the public. No tickets or pre-registration required.
